Nansen Nursery Admissions

If you, a family member or a friend have a child born between 01/09/2014-31/08/2015. They are eligible for a Nursery place to start in September 2018. Nansen offers a part time place of 15 hours per week. Under certain circumstances, the Government will fund a 30 hour place for Nursery children. The parent has to apply directly to them and meet a certain criteria. **To register for a place, please request an application form from the office.**
