



# Curriculum Overview — YEAR 1

Summer 2 2019



## English

This half term the children in Year 1 will be taking part in their Phonics Screening Tests.

They will have Guided Reading and Phonics revision work.

The children will also learn how to write:

- Engage in imaginative play representing simple characters and situations in everyday speech, gesture of movement
- Create story maps to reflect the sequence of a story pictorially
- Re-tell and rewrite stories that include main characters that are animals
- Change settings of stories
- Re-read and edit their own writing

## RE

The children will learn the significance of:

- Ramadan
- Eid
- 5 pillars of Islam
- Celebrating ourselves



## Learning Journey

Theme: 'Paws, Claws and Whiskers'

### Geography

The children will learn:

- Name continents
- Understand which animals are from the different continents and why
- Know which animals are endangered and why
- To create a fact file on animals to include where they originated from and why

### Art and Design

The children will learn:

- Use a craft materials to create the skeleton of an animal
- Design and make a an animal using clay, ensuring to include all the key identifying features of their chosen animal
- Create a piece of animal pop art inspired by the work of Andy Warhol using a variety of media

## Science

Theme: Animals

The children will learn to:

- Name different animals
- Identify animals by their groups and understand the key features of these groups
- Classify animals into groups such as amphibians, reptiles, birds, fish, mammals
- Understand what makes an animal a carnivore, herbivore or omnivore and the key features of each
- Identify animals by their teeth to determine their food choice

## Maths

The children will be learning about:

### Number—Money

- Understand the value of coins and notes
- Solve problems with the value of a monetary amount in everyday situations, using coins and notes
- Making different monetary values using a smaller denomination of money

### Number—Place Value within 100

- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 100 fluently and derive and use related facts up to 100
- Looking at the value of each digit within a 2 digit number. Splitting numbers into tens and ones

### Measurement—Time

- Understand periods of time, such as later, before, after, next, etc
- Name and write the days of the week and months of the year
- Understanding and reading the time on a clock
